Matt Ford comes from the latest generation of vocalists who, alongside Michael Bublé, Jamie Cullum and Harry Connick Jr, are carrying the baton handed to them by Frank Sinatra, Mel Tormé, Nat 'King' Cole and others, and Matt does it with absolute aplomb.

Quality songs and particularly the ones we heard last night ... can cope easily with being reset by changing pace or feel [typically ramping-up to around 200 bpm] and this is testament to both the music but also the skill of the arranger(s).

And what arranging we were privileged to hear!! Matt's ensemble consisted of a standard three-piece rhythm section, a harp, a string quartet, trombone and reeds – the unbelievable skill of each player resulted in a superb, tight, exciting sound.

These five talented individuals will perform an eclectic programme of mood changing music from the classical repertoire ... everything from solemn and reflective to rousing and uplifting!

Programme to include: the baroque trumpet piece **Suite in D major** by **Jeremiah Clarke** (wait for the familiar *Trumpet Voluntary* in the fourth movement); **A Rose Without a Thorn (Suite for Brass)**, arranged by **Elgar Howarth** (after King Henry VIII); **Symphony for Brass** by **Victor Ewald**; and **Music Hall Suite** by **Joseph Horowitz**.
